ABOUT:

To help address the climate crisis arguably one of the largest engineering projects in the history of the United Kingdom is underway with the required retrofit of millions of homes and non-domestic premises to significantly reduce heating demand and energy consumption. Playing a vital part in this ambitious and complex move is EESSH2 which includes a requirement for affordable homes to achieve an EPC Band B by 2032.

Social housing is already paving the way for energy standards in new build but also with the first milestone of the Energy Efficiency Standard for Social Housing (EESSH1) met in December 2020. According to The Scottish Housing Regulator 87% of social rented homes were already meeting an EPC Band C by the end of March 2020.

With a diverse age range of housing typologies in Scotland there is no one size fits all solution and many older buildings present unique challenges which demand care and well informed design intervention to prevent loss of heritage value or the unintended creation of building defects.

Our webinar will explain the retrofit context, the wide range of challenges, share examples projects and our approach to achieving practical cost effective solutions.
