

Livingwell Typology



The Wheatley Livingwell typology is a tried and tested service run by Wheatley Care, part of the Wheatley Group. Numerous livingwell facilities have been developed throughout recent years both within Glasgow and the wider area.

The typology has been developed to:

- Meet the needs of those aged 55+
- Promote independent living
- Improve social inclusion
- Allow check-in contact when it suits
- Facilitate a wider range of leisure and social activities for tenants
- Allow opportunities to take part in volunteering
- Work with the OkEachDay service where tenants press a button to let care know they are alright

Following discussions with Wheatley Care, we know there is an extremely high demand for facilities such as this in the area. Lochend Phase 2 been identified as a suitable location, not only due to its proximity to, local amenities and local bus routes but also due to the physical constraints of the site itself, this location is the only site that can fit accommodation of this type and the number of dwellings included is as low as can be to ensure the construction and operation of the building is efficient and economically viable
